

## **Tea Parties - What we should be demanding!**

Although there are now millions of angry taxpayers now attending tea parties, these protests lack direction where the people have no idea what they need to demand from their government. The #1 problem with this lack of direction is that existing politicians will move to join this activism and portray to lead it. Unfortunately ... politicians ... and the momentum of our present system is the problem.

A famous philosopher said, every democracy is destined to fail once a man realizes he can either work for it ... or vote for it. For 60 years we've been directed by the policies of Johnson's Great Society, the never-ending taxation of FDR's Social Security combined with numerous spending programs. These programs stem from the simple notion, where America is the richest nation, promoted heavily by the Kennedy's, where taxpayers should be made to give generously. We are now the world's greatest debtor nation due to these incompetent policies. Our government's money grab is a power grab, to keep its citizens under control and to keep that ballot box lever pull in their favor. That's 60 years of democratic policies that has created Obama's foundation of Sand.
